This letter acknowledges that the Owner of the Land has sold or transferred all of its title and interest to all logs (the "Logs") harvested from the Lands to \_\_\_\_\_\_ (the "Seller"). The Owner understands that the Seller has paid or will provide payment directly to the Owner for any Logs removed from the Lands. Alberta Pacific Forest Industries Inc. ("Al-Pac") is hereby granted access to the Lands for removal of the Logs until such time as all of the Logs are removed from the Lands.

The Owner further acknowledges that any damages to the Lands caused by the Seller are the sole responsibility of the Seller and the Owner will not hold Al-Pac liable for any such damages. The Owner(s), if an individual or individuals, consent to the use and disclosure of their "personal information", as that term is defined in "the *Personal Information Protection Act* (Alberta) as amended from time to time and any applicable similar, replacement or supplemental provincial or federal legislation or laws in effect from time to time, by the Seller and Al-Pac to confirm the ownership of the Lands.

Al-Pac is committed to maintaining an internationally competitive and sustainable enterprise with minimal effect on the environment. Maintaining forestry certification from the Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC®) helps to ensure that Al-Pac's fibre sourcing policy is in alignment with these goals.

In this regard, Al-Pac recognizes the important role that forested land plays in mitigating climate change. Additionally, forests can help to stabilize soil, protect riparian areas, mitigate the effects of wind and provide important wildlife habitat. Should the Owner wish to return the harvested land back to a forested state in the future please contact Al-Pac's Silviculture Team for more information at 780-525-8000.

The Owner will not knowingly compromise the FSC Controlled Wood Requirements as noted above. The Logs have not come from: illegally harvested forests; forests harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights; forests in which high conservation values are threatened; or forests in which genetically modified trees are being planted.

The owner will notify Al-Pac's Purchase Wood Coordinator at 780-525-8000 immediately if there is any opposition to the harvest from Indigenous Peoples with legal or customary rights within the harvest area.
